
Open Government Data Programme KEY INSIGHTS

Central and local government agencies and Crown Research Institutes were surveyed to understand their level of maturity in different aspects of open data management. Key insights from the results will help shape the development of support and resources to enable agencies to release more open data.



28% do tailor contracts to allow data to be released openly
